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# Hookup

## This Manual

It is recommended that you read this manual before unpacking, installing or operating your new TanTime™ System™ Timers. Important information is covered in this manual that will ease installation and ensure trouble-free operation. Failure to follow setup & operation directions could result in damages not covered by the warranty.

## Physical Connections

### Connecting the Bed to the System™ OEM Timer

A 5 wire, gray hookup cable, approximately 6 feet long, is fixed to the Timer. The other end of this cable is fitted with a 5-pin, latching connector that will mate with the bed's connector. This cable provides all power to the timer, all signals between the bed and the timer and access to the bed's remote Start/Stop button.

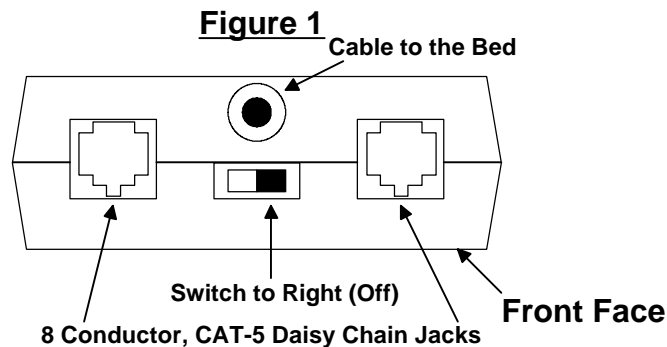
### Setting the Switch Position (See Figure 1)

The switch on top of the System™ OEM Timer should be in the **Right** (Off) position except when one of the following are true:

- The timer is the last timer of a daisy chain connected to a front room controller and the End Of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™) will not illuminate. Placing the switch to the **Left** (on) position supplies power to the .SY-EOL™
- The timer is to be remotely controlled by another System™ RU-DS™ or SY-TT-1™ timer connected to a remote Master Controller. Placing the switch to the **Left** (on) position supplies power to the Master Controller.
- When using a Third Party Interface (TPI) to use the Timer with a non-daisy-chained front room controller.

### Installing an End of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™)

To start, all OEM System™ Timers must have the switches set to the **Right** (Off) position. The SY-EOL™ is used only in the last bed of a daisy chain connected to a front room controller. This bed would have only one CAT-5 cable coming to it. The SY-EOL™ should be placed in the unused Daisy Chain connector, and the switch on the timer set to the **Right** (Off). If the SY-EOL™ does NOT illuminate when the Front room controller and Timers are powered on, move the switch to the **Left** (On) position where the SY-EOL™ will illuminate.

## Connecting to External Controllers

The timer may be operated in a Stand-Alone mode as connected above, or connected to an external controller such as:

- A front room controller from TanTime™, T-Max®, or Intellitan®
- Remote Master Timer from TanTime™ System™, T-Max® or Intellitan® CCS IV®
- Third Party Interface for a front room controller Not from TanTime™, T-Max® or Intellitan® CCS IV®

## Connecting to a System™ Front Room Controller

The System™ OEM Timer may be used with a System™ front room controller using CAT-5 cable. The Timers interconnect in a daisy chain fashion to the controller. The 8 pin modular jacks on the Timer are interchangeable. For use with a TanTime™ TT-40 System™ refer to **Figure 2** and the TT-40 Users' Manual.

If the Timer is the last timer in the daisy chain, install a TanTime™ End Of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™) in the open connector. [See **Installing an End of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™)** above.]

## Connecting to a T-Max® or Intellitan® Front Room Controller or Equivalent

The System™ OEM Timer may be used with a T-Max® or Intellitan® CCS IV® front room controller or equivalent. A TanTime™ SY-MAK™ kit is required to adapt between the Cat-5 cable connections in the System™ timers and 4 line modular jack in the T-Max® or Intellitan® equipment. Interconnect the timers in a daisy chain fashion to the controller. The 8 pin modular jacks on the back of the System™ OEM Timer are interchangeable. Refer to **Figure 3** and the front room controller Users' Manual.

If the System™ timer is the last timer in the daisy chain, install a TanTime™ End Of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™) in the open connector. [See **Installing an End of Line Terminator (SY-EOL™)** above.]

## Operation with Third Party Interface (TPI)

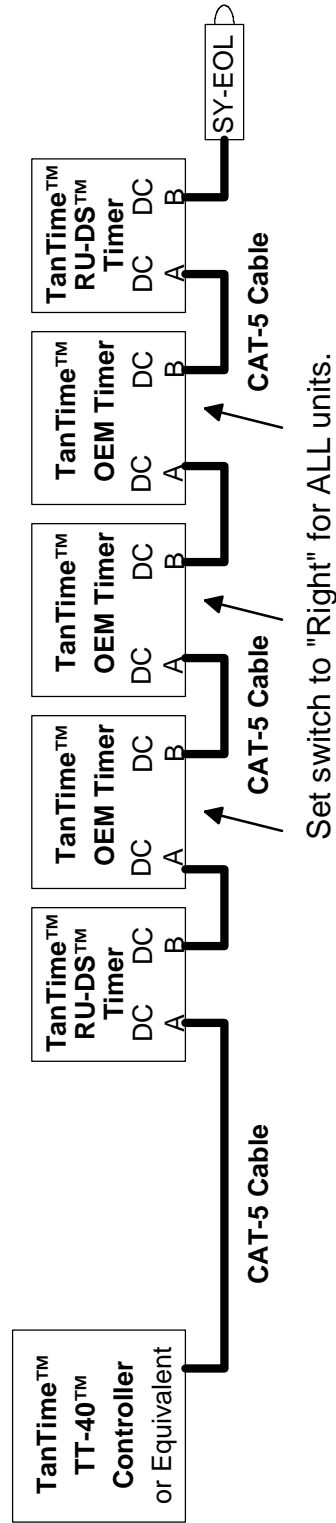
When connecting to a controller Not from TanTime™, T-Max® or Intellitan® CCS IV®, a Third Party Interface (TPI) cable is required (TanTime™ part number SY-TPI.) The TPI cable must be plugged into one of the 8 position modular connectors and the other one must be empty. The Timer switch must be set to the Left (On). The timer must be set to TPI mode as instructed in the Operation Instructions for your System™ OEM timer revision. The timer revision number is shown on the display immediately after power is supplied to the timer. The Operation Instructions are found on the TanTime™ Website, [www.tantime.com](http://www.tantime.com) under Support.

When TPI mode is active, and the TPI cable installed, connecting the two open wires at the end of the TPI cable together will start a session. The session will last until the maximum programmed Session Length is achieved or the TPI wire contact opens again, whichever comes first. While in TPI mode the timer will display "3P" if either timer button is pressed.

The Timer will remain in TPI mode even after power and the TPI cable have been removed. See the Operation Instructions for your timer revision to deactivate the TPI mode.

**Hookup with a TanTime™ System™ Controller**

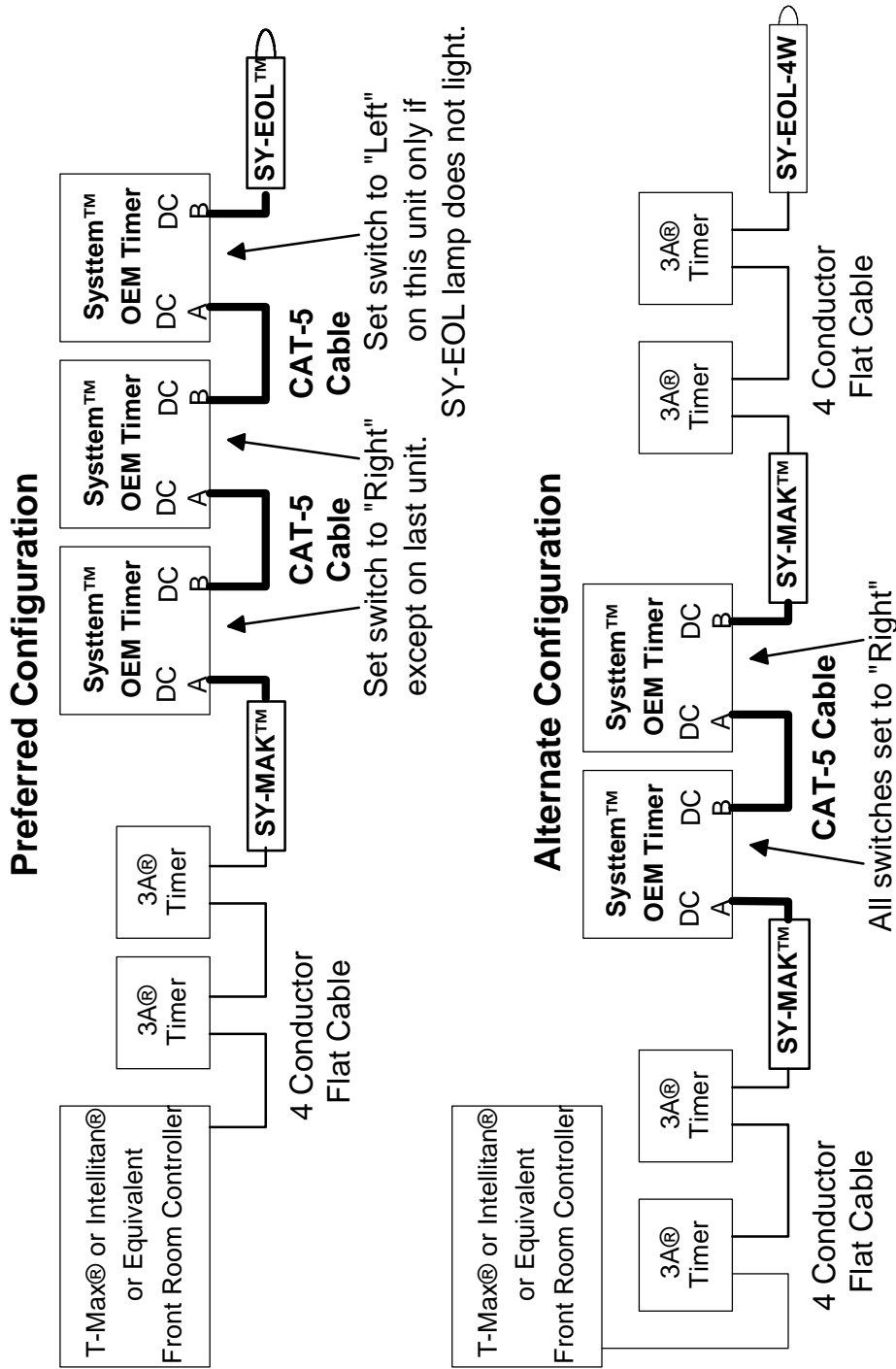


NOTE: Install an End Of Line Terminator in the last timer in the daisy chain per the instruction given in this manual.

DC A and DC B are abbreviations for Daisy Chain A and Daisy Chain B.

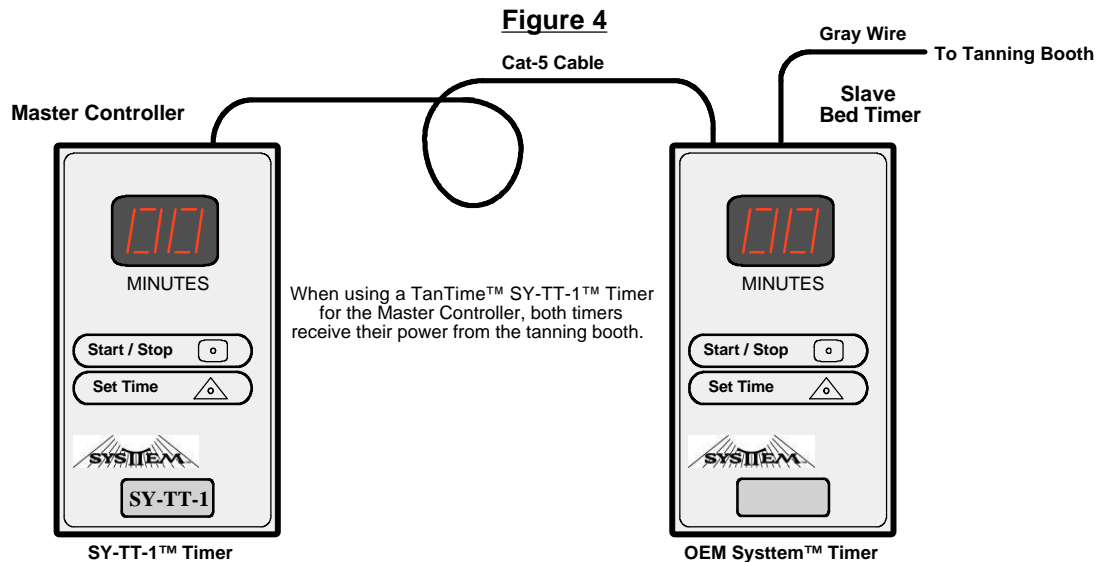

## Connecting the OEM Timer to a Master Timer

A single System™ OEM timer may be remotely controlled by another timer configured as a Master Controller. The System™ OEM timer will operate as a slave to the Master Controller. See your Timer Operation Instructions for setup and operation.

If the Master Controller is a TanTime™ RU-DS™ or SY-TT-1™ Timer, use Cat-5 Cable to connect the two timers together. The Master Controller does not need a separate power supply as it may be powered by sliding the OEM timer switch to the **Left** (on) position. This will supply power to the Master Controller through the Cat-5 cable. (See Figure 4 for using a SY-TT-1™ Timer as the Master Controller.)

If the master controller is a RU-XM™, or a timer supplied by T-Max® or Intellitan® you must use a SY-MAK™ Multipurpose Adapter Kit to connect to the Master Controller. The Master Controller will need to be powered separately.
